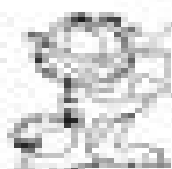


**THE PAST SIMPLE**

**Introduction**

We use the Past Simple for actions which started and finished at a specific time in the past.

• I **played** football yesterday.

• They **went** to school last week.

**played** and **went** are **IRREGULAR** verbs. However they form the Past Simple by adding **-ed** to the verb.
