The seed germinates (sprouts) when it gets water, air, and warmth.

Each seed contains an embryo and stored food.

The seedling grows, using air, light, water, and nutrients from the soil.

The plant grows stems, leaves, roots, and flowers.

At the end of the cycle the seeds are scattered. These seeds may germinate to start a new plant.
