### Rules for he, she and it

1. Add "s" to the base verb	work => works
2. Add "ies" to verbs ending in consonant + "y"	carry => carries
3. Add "es" to verbs ending in "s, z, ch, sh, x"	push => pushes
4. Irregular forms (no rules apply)	have => has
