

Volume of a Rectangular Prism

Reminder

The volume of a rectangular prism is computed by multiplying the length times the width times the height of the prism or $V = l \times w \times h$ or $V = lwh$

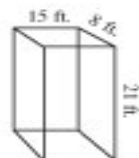
