

## *Sentences & Sentence Fragments*

*A **sentence** tells a complete thought.*

*It has a subject (a who or what) and a predicate (which begins with a verb).*

*A **sentence fragment** does not tell a complete thought.*

*It may be missing a subject (a who or what) and/or part of the predicate (which includes the verb).*
