First reported planting of a grove in Texas was 1893

- Bluebonnet Texas Red Grapefruit Monarch Butterfly Armadillo

This chile was named after the city of Xalapa in Veracruz, Mexico

- Guadalupe Bass Jalapeno Texas Red Grapefruit Monarch Butterfly

Bears sweet edible nuts, deep brown in color, that range from 1 to 2 inches in length

- Monarch Butterfly Pecan Tree Mockingbird Jalapeno

Texas State Motto

- Armadillo Friendship Jalapeno Pecan Tree

A genus of small isopod Crustacea that can roll themselves into a ball

- Jalapeno Texas Red Grapefruit Guadalupe Bass Armadillo

Mimics songs of other birds

- Bluebonnet Pecan Tree Mockingbird Jalapeno

Named for its color and the resemblance of its petal to a woman's sunbonnet

- Texas Red Grapefruit Guadalupe Bass Friendship Bluebonnet

Has deep orange wings with black and white markings, known for its long-distance migrations

- Pecan Tree Monarch Butterfly Friendship Texas Red Grapefruit

May spawn a second time in the summer

- Guadalupe Bass Armadillo Mockingbird Texas Red Grapefruit

The hardy breed of open range cattle that defined the western trail drive and serves as the mascot for the University of Texas

- Mockingbird Longhorn Jalapeno Armadillo
