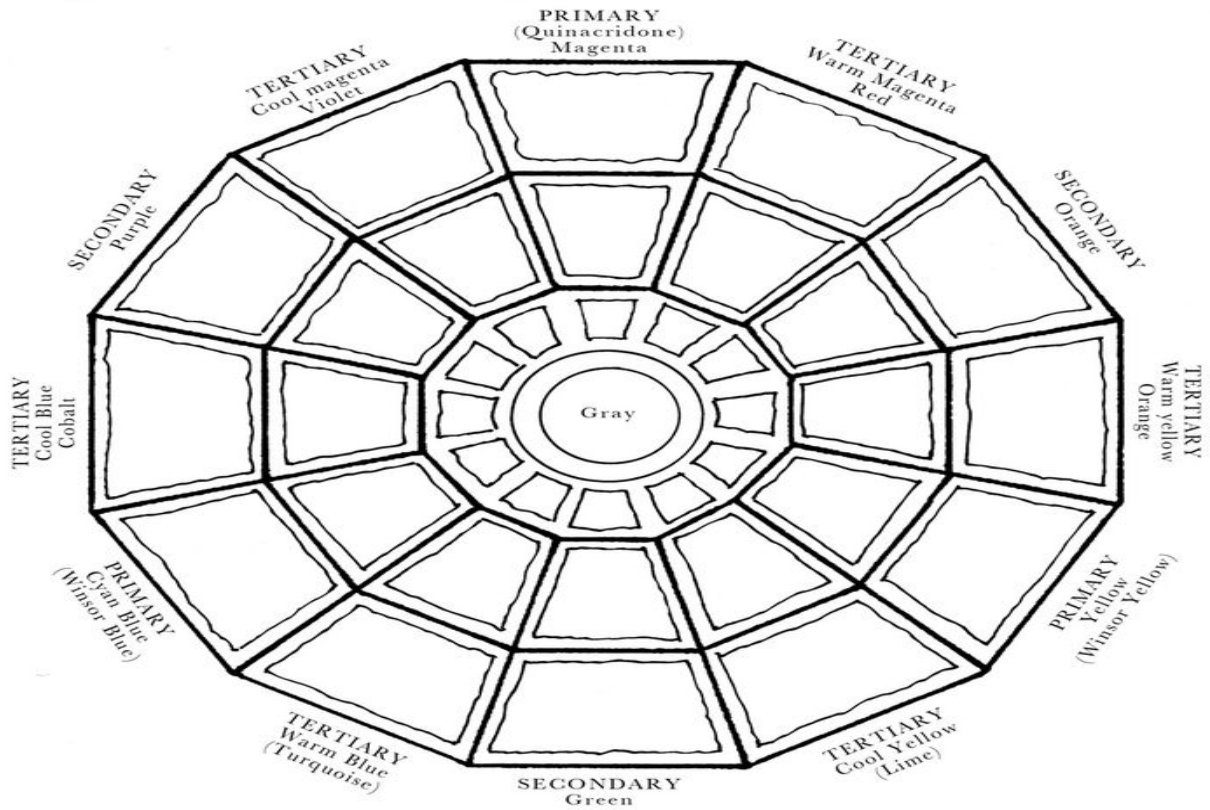


## Color Wheel # 1

You can create a full spectrum of color using the primary colors: Magenta, Cyan-Blue & Yellow.  
Secondary colors are combinations of two primary colors.  
Tertiary colors are combinations of primary and secondary colors. Sometimes this is called an intermediate color.  
Tertiary colors are also created when you mix complimentary colors.  
Opposite colors are called complementary colors.



### Why are Complementary Colors Important in Color Theory?

When placed next to each other, complementary colors make each other appear brighter, more intense. The shadow of an object will also contain its complementary color, for example the shadow of a green apple will contain some red.
