2. _____ A civilian organization sponsored by the United States government; helps people in developing countries.
3. _____ The Soviet Union built nuclear missile bases in Cuba. Kennedy demanded they withdraw their weapons and ordered the Navy to surround Cuba. The Soviet premier agreed to remove the weapons in exchange for the U.S. promise not to invade Cuba.
4. _____ Kennedy backed a group of Cuban exiles who tried to overthrow Castro. Their invasion failed.
5. _____ The vice President to President Kennedy
6. _____ 35th President of the United States
7. _____ President Kennedy was shot on November 22, 1963, as his motorcade traveled through Dallas, Texas
