

REFLEXIVE PRONOUNS

- We use reflexive pronouns after the verb when the subject and the object are the same person. It refers back to the subject.

I washed the dishes **myself**.
She called the president **herself**.

- If we use **by** before the reflexive pronouns it means "alone".
I cleaned the house **by myself**. I was **alone**.
