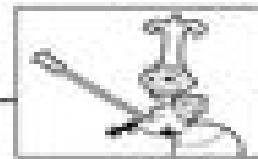


What's the Difference?

Sorting objects with one different attribute



Help the Queen Bee figure out what is different about her friends. Color the pictures that are alike. Draw an X on the one that is different.



Buy a bag of dry mixed beans (7 beans each) from the grocery store. Place six small bowls in front of your child. Ask your little one to take a good look at the wide variety of beans. Now instruct him or her to separate the beans by color. Ask your child to look at just one thing (color) that makes the beans different from one another. Then help your child select six different-colored beans and place each in a different bowl. If you have more bean colors, you can extend this activity by adding more bowls.
