Value Village is a thrift store. At Value Village, shoppers can find used clothing, shoes, jewelry, toys, books, DVDs, furniture and many things for the house.

Value Village gets these things from non-profit groups. People donate things they don't need to a non-profit group. The non-profit group sells them to Value Village to make money.

Value Village also gets things from people who go to the store. Value Village gives the money it gets for those things to non-profit groups, too. Value Village pays more than 180 non-profit groups more than \$17 million each year.
