7. Consider some of these questions as you are writing your critique.
 - Were the characters believable?
 - Were the actors appropriately cast?
 - Were the settings appropriate and effective?
 - Is the sound track effective and appropriate? Is the music appropriate or is it inappropriate?
 - Did the film make use of the symbols or symbolism as we studied in the novel? Were they used effectively? How does the symbolism in the film contribute to or enhance the film's overall theme?
 - How was the image you had from the novel different from the imagery you saw in the movie?
 - In general, how was your appreciation of the movie compared to the novel?
