<p>"Walked" must be followed by an object. If something is "walked" it is always operated by another force. Ex: The child <u>walked</u> toward the fifty percent test results.</p>	<p>"Walk" is not followed by an object. If something "walks" it goes operatively something by itself. Ex: My computer <u>walked</u> out of the last month.</p>
