

How We Communicate

As people, we have to communicate. There are four "blocks" that we use to convey meaning: content, what we describe, how or why.

- We use **nouns** to refer to people, places, things, activities.
man, woman
- We use **adjectives** to describe people, places, things & ideas.
the short man, the tall woman
- We use **verbs** to show action, or the condition of things.
I started the story **with** a pen. The girl **was** crying.
The short man **is** painting. The tall woman **is** reading.
I **love** it being the short man **as** a painter. The tall woman **is** a writer.
The short man **is** a tall leader. The tall woman **is** confident.
- We use **adverbs** to tell how, when, where, how much, etc.
The short man paints **well**. The tall woman runs **fast**.
The short man **always** paints well. The tall woman **usually** runs fast.
The short man **always** paints **near** **where** he lives.
The tall woman **usually** runs **there** in the park.
The short man paints **every** day. The tall woman **occasionally** fast.
