

## How We Communicate

As people, we have to communicate. Here are four "blocks" that we use to clearly convey our ideas and what we really see or write.

- We use **nouns** to refer to people, places, things, activities.  
**man, woman**
- We use **adjectives** to describe people, places, things & ideas.  
**the short man, the tall woman**
- We use **verbs** to show action, or the condition of things.  
I started the story **last night**. Though **everywhere**.  
The short man **is painting**. The tall woman **is reading**.  
I **love** it being the short man **as a painter**. The tall woman **is a writer**.  
The short man **is not** tall. The tall woman **is confident**.
- We use **adverbs** to tell how, when, where, how much, etc.  
The short man **is painting well**. The tall woman **isn't** tall.  
The short man **always** paints well. The tall woman **usually** reads fast.  
The short man **always** paints **very** well **where** he lives.  
The tall woman **isn't** very **tall** in the yard.  
The short man paints **every** well. The tall woman **isn't usually** tall.
