
- 2. Holding up the pictures, one at a time, teacher and students share their thoughts about the pictures. Excitedly respond to different students' diverse interpretation of the pictures.
- 3. Teacher displays the Favorite Pictures page or a blank page.



4. After explaining that this page belongs in the *Ideas Section* of the Vocabulary Book, teacher glues a magazine picture on the page.



- 5. The teacher then models writing about the picture in his/her journal.
- Students then choose a picture and glue it on their Favorite Picture page or a blank piece of paper in the Idea Section of their Vocabulary Book.
- After attaching the picture to their Favorite Picture page, students write about it in their journals. More pictures can be added as the year progresses.
- 8. Writers share their journals with the class.
