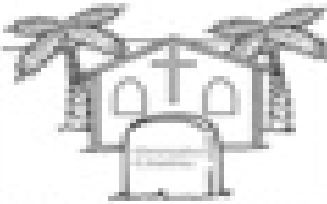

Directions: Cut-out the illustrations below. Study each illustration, and read its caption carefully. Then arrange the illustrations in the order that these events happened.



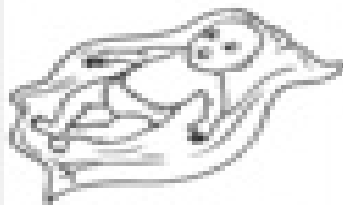
Columbus died on May 20, 1506. Later, his remains were moved to Santo Domingo.

In 1502, during Columbus's third trip to the New World, he was arrested and chained, bringing his career as the governor of an island to an end.



Christopher Columbus was born in 1451 in Genoa, Italy. He became interested in navigation when he was 14 years old.



On August 3, 1492, the Niña, the Pinta, and the Santa María set out from the port of Palos, Spain.



Columbus's second voyage focused on establishing permanent Spanish control of the islands.



Columbus's long search for financial support led him to the king and queen of Spain.



On Columbus's first voyage, he explored several Caribbean islands.



Columbus hoped to gain honor and wealth by setting sail to reach the Spice Islands in the East.
