• using adjectives and adverbs

Example: The dog ~~was~~ ~~as~~ ~~fast~~ ~~as~~ ~~the~~ ~~cat~~. (The cat is faster.)
The cat ~~was~~ ~~as~~ ~~slow~~ ~~as~~ ~~the~~ ~~dog~~. (The dog is faster.)
