How do I get a ...?

HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA

An Adult High School can be earned by choosing either Option 1 or 2.

OPTION 1: You may take all 34 courses.

OPTION 2: You may take the GED plus 10 specified classes.

Note: You can obtain credit for classes taken from 9th to 12th grades in the U.S. or your native country (official transcripts are required).

G.E.D. CERTIFICATE

OPTION 3: G.E.D. only.
