

Objective: Making questions "Who is the subject"

Important: If "who" is used as the subject, decide not use "who/whom" in the question.

Example:

Question	Answer
A) Who is the subject? Components	Answer: Who is the subject? Components are prepositions first .
B) Who made the movie? Director	A: Who made the movie? A: Who made the movie?
