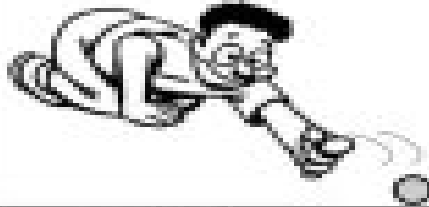


Math Word Problems Worksheet 6



Matt likes playing marbles. At the beginning of the week, he had a bag with 24 marbles in it. On Monday, he won 28 marbles. On Tuesday, he lost 11 marbles. On Wednesday, he visited his cousin who gave him 58 marbles. On Thursday, he won 3 marbles. On Friday, he lost 12 marbles. On Saturday, he bought 28 marbles.

How many marbles did Matt have in his bag on Sunday?



Alice bought a 24 marble bag of shiny blue ribbon.

Alice spent 2 marbles to wear on her hair.

Alice gave her mother 16 marbles to use as a gift.

Alice spent half a marble to tie around her neck to match.

Alice gave her best friend Betty 3 marbles.

Alice spent half a marble to decorate her pencil.

How much more Alice has left?

Black Pirate Steve raided a village and stole the following:
5 bags, each filled with 58 pieces of gold,
a chest filled with 288 pieces of gold,
a bracelet threaded with 8 pieces of gold,
a piggy bank filled with 144 pieces of gold,
an altar filled with 124 pieces of gold and
a large leather purse filled with 48 pieces of gold.

How many pieces of gold did he get altogether?
If he shared half of this with his 4 crew members,
How much do they each get?



This bird eats 24 pieces of bird seed every morning and 28 pieces every night.

How many does she eat in a day?

How many does she eat in a week?

How many does she eat in 4 weeks?

How many does she eat in 52 weeks?

Patrick has been working hard all day painting a house.

It took him 2 hours and 15 minutes to paint the lounge room,
1 hour and 20 minutes to paint the bathroom, 2 hours to paint
the hallway, 1 hour and 10 minutes to paint each of the three
bedrooms and 2 hours and 35 minutes to paint the kitchen.

How long has he been painting? If he started at 7:00 a.m. and
had a half hour break, when did he finish?
