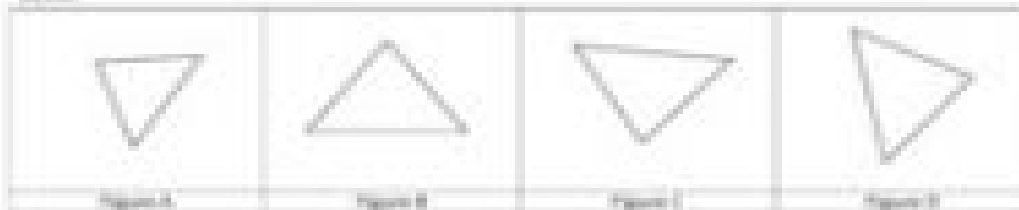

**One of These Things is Not Like the Others**

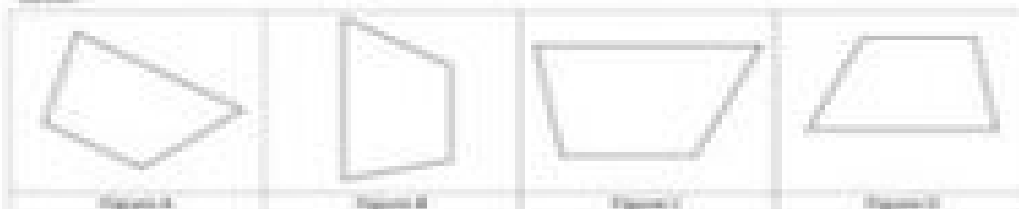
