### Final names- Irregular

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- Names that end in **th, sh, ge, se, ce, de, te** form the plural by adding **'s'** (often irregular). Here's an example: **bus -> buses**

Turn the irregular nouns below into plural

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- Names that end in **'y'** which are preceded by a consonant form the plural by changing the **'y'** to **'i'** and then adding an **'s'**. Here's an example: **city -> cities**

fly -> \_\_\_\_\_ penny -> \_\_\_\_\_  
body -> \_\_\_\_\_ spy -> \_\_\_\_\_

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- Names that end in **'s'** which are preceded by a vowel form the plural by changing the **'s'** to **'es'** and then adding an **'s'**. Here's an example: **fish -> fishes**

fish -> \_\_\_\_\_ fish -> \_\_\_\_\_  
class -> \_\_\_\_\_ watch -> \_\_\_\_\_

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- Names that end in **'er'** form the plural by **dropping the 'e'** and then adding **'s'** and an **'r'**. Here's an example: **war -> wars**
