Preparedness	Student is completely prepared and has obviously rehearsed the speech before.	Student seems pretty prepared and has definitely practiced, but struggled in some places.	The student is somewhat prepared, has had some practice but was confused or faltered in parts.
Speaks with Clarity and Fluency	Speaks clearly and distinctly all (100-95%) of the time, and mispronounces no words.	Speaks clearly and distinctly almost all (95-85%) of the time and only mispronounces one or two words.	Speaks clearly and distinctly some (85-60%) of the time and mispronounces several words.
Visual Aid is relevant to the presentation	Student has clearly connected the presentation to the visual aid. Whatever the student says is further demonstrated in the visual representation.	Student has connected the presentation to the visual aid, however some material is not explained in detail. Expression and eye contact	Student makes a unique effort to engage the class members and maintain eye contact. He/she uses appropriate gestures, asks questions, interacts, etc.	Student has some engagement with the class and does maintain eye contact, use appropriate gestures, ask questions, etc.	Student has limited engagement with the class and struggles to make eye contact.
Obvious thesis/main idea; there is a point to presentation	There is a clear purpose and overall point to the presentation.	There is a fairly clear point to the presentation but some parts were confusing.	There is a point to the presentation but it is not always clear.
