noun	a person, animal, place, object or abstract idea, such as house, dog, city or happiness
pronoun	a word that can replace a noun in a sentence, such as he, her or mine
verb	an action word, such as <i>runs</i> , <i>drank</i> , or <i>reading</i> , or a word that shows a state of being, such as <i>am</i> or <i>loves</i>
adjective	a word that describes a noun, such as red, old or sad
adverb	a word that gives more information about how an action is carried out, such as quickly, late or well
preposition	a word that shows the relationship between one part of a sentence and another, such as behind, towards or after
conjunction	a word that joins two clauses in a sentence, such as because, but or whereas
