What do you want to learn? Pick an idea or concept. Purpose: Hypothesis: Predict what the answer to the problem will be. Make an educated guess that can be tested. What do you need to know? Find out as much about your idea as you can. Research: Procedure: Plan and design a test. How are you going to find out what you want to learn? How many days, weeks, hours and/or minutes will it take? How often will you measure your results?
