<b>Subject</b> Arabic  IL standards for teaching a foreign language	<p><b>Objectives:</b> Students will learn the words: mother, father, sister, brother, grandmother and grandfather in Arabic                  Students will learn the verb like/love in Arabic.                  Students will learn an Arabic song about family members.                  Review conjugation of verbs for subject/verb agreement.</p> <p><b>Procedure:</b> Students will watch and listen to an Arabic song about family members. Then, through watching and listening, students will learn to identify the Arabic word for each family member.                  Teacher will repeat each word for clear pronunciation and students will repeat after her.                  Students will watch and sing along with the CD a few times.                  Students will be grouped in sevens, and each will have a turn singing the song to the others in the group.                  Teacher and students will review the conjugation of the verb "want" and classroom objects by asking students to say a sentence asking for various objects.</p> <p><b>Assessment:</b> observation, listening to students sing the song together and then within the group.</p>
