8. **OVERLAP**

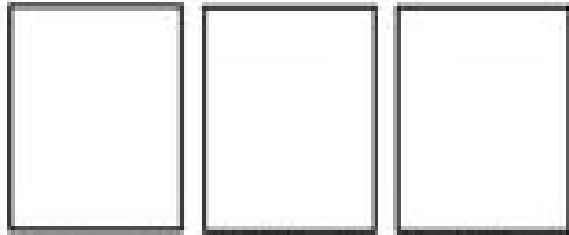
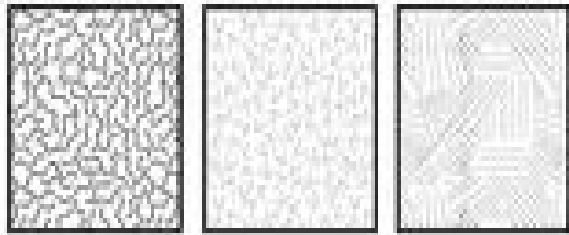
