

## The Judicial Branch

The job of the judicial branch is to oversee the United States court system. The Supreme Court is the head of the judicial branch. The Supreme Court rules whether an issue brought forth is constitutional or unconstitutional.

There are nine justices on the Supreme Court. There are eight associate justices, or judges, and one chief justice, all nominated by the President and approved by the Senate. Supreme Court justices have no term limit, which means they can serve until they decide to leave, or die in office.

The Supreme Court is the highest court in the United States. All decisions the Supreme Court makes are final, and often not precedents.
