## Latitude & Longitude

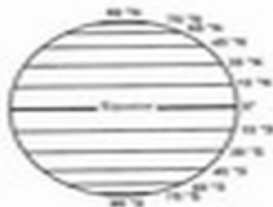
Everywhere on Earth has a \_\_\_\_\_
