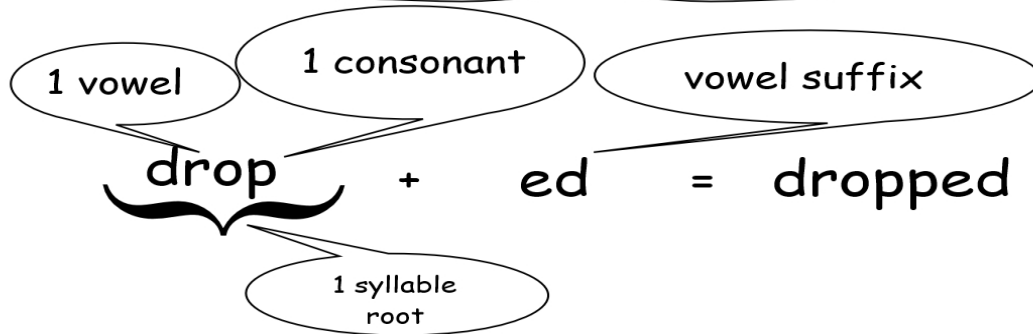


## 1-1-1 Rule – Doubling Rule

1 syllable words ending in 1 consonant after 1 vowel  
double the final consonant before a vowel suffix.  
(Doubling keeps the vowel short)



Examples:	<u>Base Word</u>		<u>Suffix</u>	<u>New Word</u>
Double	run	+	ing	_____
	sad	+	est	_____
	wet	+	er	_____

Don't Double

Heat \_\_\_\_\_ + ing \_\_\_\_\_ = \_\_\_\_\_  
 Why didn't you double? \_\_\_\_\_

Warm \_\_\_\_\_ + ed \_\_\_\_\_ = \_\_\_\_\_  
 Why didn't you double? \_\_\_\_\_

Fit \_\_\_\_\_ + ness \_\_\_\_\_ = \_\_\_\_\_  
 Why didn't you double \_\_\_\_\_

**Don't double the final letters W, X, and Y.**  
**Examples: boxing, snowing, player.**
