Directions: Choose a project to complete for your midterm assignment:

**Project # 1:** Teach me a lesson. Choose a topic from below and create a lesson to teach it to children. Try to make it a fun lesson. You can use posters, the white board, computer resources (like powerpoint) to help you teach the lesson. Give a quiz at the end of your lesson.

Here are your choices for teaching the lesson:

1. Teach about the different kinds of sentences: Statement, Question, Exclamation, Command (see page 8 of the green book).
2. Teach the vocabulary words from one of the stories that we read. You can find the words at the front of each story.
3. Teach how to change regular adjectives into comparative adjectives (warm → warmer).

**Project # 2:** Create a movie. Use [stupefix.com](http://stupefix.com) to create a movie that includes pictures, words, and sounds. The words must be your OWN words (do not just copy from the book). The movie must be at least 5 minutes long.

Here are your choices for the movie option:

1. Make a movie version of "LAFFF" to share (see pages 37-54 in the green book).
2. Make a movie version of "The Lotus Seed" to share (see pages 185-193 in the green book).
3. Make a movie version of "Brothers in Hope" to share (see pages 231-250 in the green book).

**Project # 3:** Create a scrapbook for one of the stories we have read this semester. The scrapbook must be at least 6 pages, and it has to have a cover. Use magazines, internet resources, and construction paper to recreate the story. Make sure you have descriptions under your pictures to explain (just like your glog projects).
