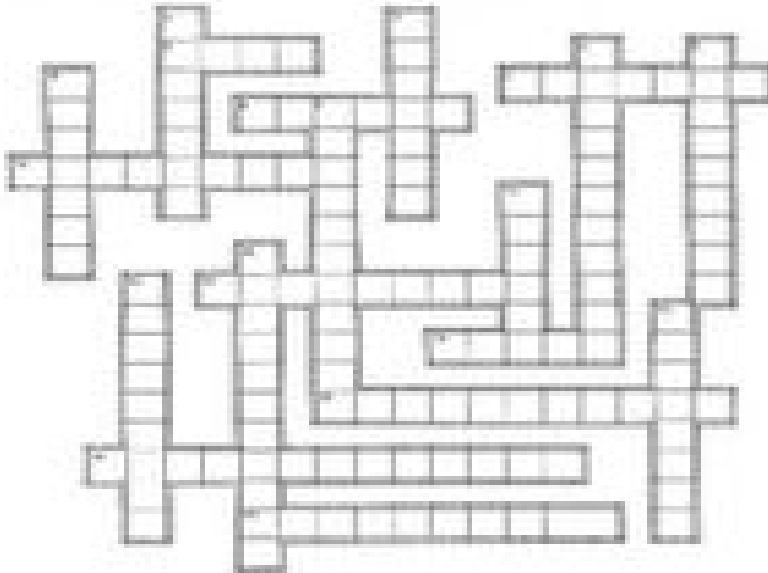


Respiratory System Crossword
