Book Jacket Project

For this book report, you will create a book jacket that tells about the book. You will be some of the information, but you must also create your own ideas for the jacket.

Check off your measurement after you're finished.

Requirements:

CONSTRUCTION OF THE BOOK JACKET

To construct the jacket for the book, use square, rectangular, and triangular pieces.

1. Cut a piece of tag board 11 inches high by 21 inches wide.
 2. Fold the left side, meeting in center and glue a reinforcement.
 3. Also glue across 11 inches from the left side.
 4. Repeat steps 1-3 three times down the page.
 5. Make cuts and a piece, taking care to measure 4 inch marks across 11 inch sections.
 6. Make strips 1-4 inches from the right side of the book.
 7. Use the glue to glue across the 4 inch sections.
 8. Fold the right side across, making 11 inch sections and glue across the top edge. It should now look like the diagram above & use tape.
 9. Cover the book jacket template with the material you wish to use for the book jacket.
 10. Starting from the left, glue together the pages 1-5.
 11. Finish the book jacket top. Start from the left, glue together the pages 6-10. You are now ready to glue together the pages for your book jacket.
- CONSTRUCTION OF THE PANELS (A-C) (Make them out of tag board)**

When making the panels for your book jacket, you should use the corresponding template, then glue them into place with a glue stick. Do NOT use staples on the tag board. **ALL THE WRITING must be written complete.**

FRONT PANEL A: Design a cover for your book jacket that includes the title of the book, the author's name, and your name. Include a reader's reaction. (Remember to sign)

FRONT PANEL B: Use creative techniques to design a scene for your book jacket. Include the title of the book and the author's name. Write the name of the publisher and a portion of the scene.

BACK COVER PANEL C: On the top half of panel C write a paragraph that highlights the most exciting element of the book. This paragraph should include the reader's reaction to the book and should not include your personal opinion. On the bottom half of panel C write a one-paragraph review of the book. This paragraph should tell what you liked and disliked about the book.
