1. You do not use the correct subject-verb agreement.
 - That box of chocolates are very expensive. x
 - That box of chocolates is very expensive. ✓
2. You use the plural form of an uncountable noun with a phrasal quantifier.
 - Add two spoons of oils when frying the fish. x
 - Add two spoons of oil when frying the fish. ✓
