

A: You are going to meet one of a host of about London's best-known Agents. After you have read it quickly, look at the questions with another host page.

B - Passenger Control

If you are not travelling to another flight within Britain or Northern Ireland you must use Board/Passport Control and Customs immediately after leaving the plane. If you are not British or a citizen of a country in the European Community, you must show a valid international identity card before you pass the passport control. The certificate for passengers leaving the UK is a form you can obtain from the British Embassy.

When you enter the terminal building from the airport, show the following signs. They say that you are not a flight crew member when you reach CUSTOMS CONTROL. There is one channel for holders of European Community passports and a second channel for other passengers.

B - Getting Your Luggage

If you have luggage which you carried in the aircraft hold, follow the following instructions after you pass the passport control. If you have only hand luggage, and through-the-luggage system procedures for CUSTOMS are:

C - Customs

Passengers arriving from a country outside the European Community are allowed to bring with them a certain quantity of duty free items. You can get information about how much you can bring through the following model Customs Declaration for baggage movements.

There are four Customs Channels, the Red Channel, the Green Channel and the Blue Channel. If you have something to declare, or if you are not sure about anything, the following procedure goes through the Red Channel. Passengers arriving from outside the European Community who declare their goods go through the Green Channel. Passengers arriving from outside the European Community with nothing to declare go through the Blue Channel.

Please note that Customs Officers may stop you during the international baggage as you go through the Green or Blue Channel.

C - Transit Passengers

If you are immediately transferring to another flight at an airport that is not listed for disembarkation or arrival in Northern Ireland, you are a transit passenger and do not have to go through the procedures above.

All transit passengers should follow the black and yellow TRANSIT signs. Stand well at the Travel Baggage and at other points in the terminal which your airline requires you to use. Signatures gate.
