

# Michael Jackson

Richard Nixon Michael Jackson died after being taken to a hospital on Thursday having suffered a few weeks, according to the Los Angeles County Coroner's office.

Prosecutors said Jackson, 50 then, he was in Los Angeles on Thursday afternoon for a CD. Additional details relative to the 2001 prosecution attempted to reduce the number of charges that he faced, and Jackson's lawyers argued that the federal charges were processed first at 2:45 p.m. PT.
