### 1. line graph

- a. a diagram that show the frequency of data. An X placed above a number on a number line each time that number occurs in a set of data.
- b. a relationship between two variables that can be described by a straight line when variable values are plotted on a graph
- c. a graph that shows change in data over time where some value of time will be on the x-axis.

### 3. linear relationship

- a. a relationship between two variables that can be described by a straight line when variable values are plotted on a graph
- b. a diagram that show the frequency of data. An X placed above a number on a number line each time that number occurs in a set of data.
- c. the sum of the data, divided by the number of items in the data set.

### 5. literal vs. figurative meaning

- a. relates to the meanings of words and phrases or expressions, for example: "She was all ears" has a figurative meaning (she was listening intently) as well as a literal meaning (the ears on her head were larger than normal)
- b. the ability to read and write
- c. the art of composition, either written or spoken, intended to bring a specific emotional response through meaning, sound and rhythm

### 2. line plot

- a. the side opposite the right angle in the right triangle
- b. a diagram that show the frequency of data. An X placed above a number on a number line each time that number occurs in a set of data
- c. a relationship between two variables that can be described by a straight line when variable values are plotted on a graph

### 4. fluency

- a. the art of composition, either written or spoken, intended to bring a specific emotional response through meaning, sound and rhythm
- b. the ability to read and write
- c. a restatement of a text that expresses the meaning of the original in another form, generally for a clearer and fuller explanation
