A **adjective** is a word that modified a noun or a pronoun.
Examples: hot, fast, tall, fast

A descriptive adjective: beautiful, delicious, intelligent, or little sunny.
Examples: blue, green, blue, blue, blue, blue

A proper adjectives or adjectives that referred from a proper noun. It always begins with capital letter.
Examples: French, Chinese, American
