- 3. Rachel has 400 cookies. She gave 42 of them to each of her 6 friends. How many were left over?
- 4. A restaurant sold 11 boxes of lobster, which had 20 lobsters in each box, and 19 boxes of 30 shrimp in each box. How much seafood did they sell altogether?
- 5. There were 28 engineers (mapmakers) who were invited to a party. Another 23 engineers were invited to the party from another company. Four of these engineers had made big mistakes on their last project. They messed up on 2 of the maps they were working on. How many engineers made it to the party?
