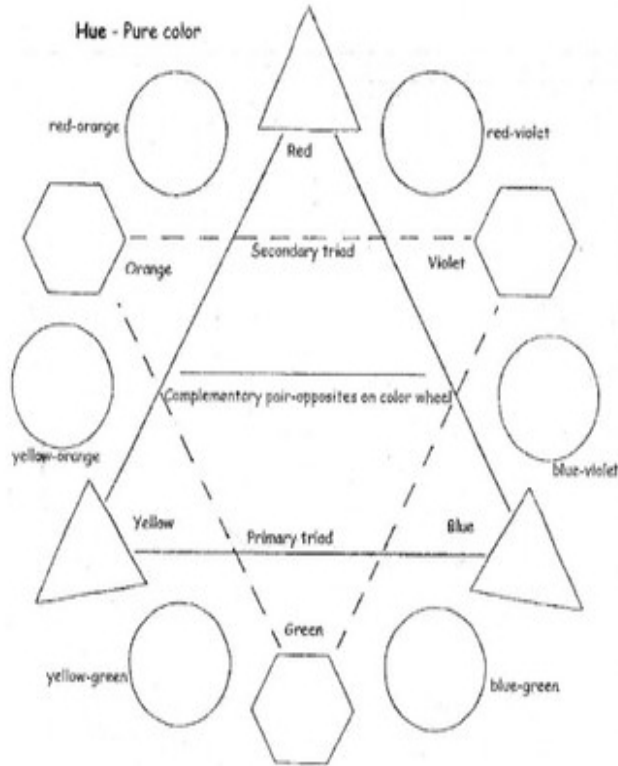


COLOR THEORY



Intensity - The brightness or dullness of a color, also called it's saturation.

RED			NEUTRAL			GREEN
BLUE			NEUTRAL			ORANGE
YELLOW			NEUTRAL			VIOLET

Value - The lightness or darkness of a color.

white	TINTS	hue	SHADES	black

Achromatic - Without color; black and the mixtures of white and black

white						black

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Primary Hues - Red, Yellow and Blue, these colors cannot be mixed from any other color

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Secondary Hues - Orange, Green and Violet obtained by mixing two equal amounts of primary colors

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Intermediate (Tertiary) - Hues - Are found between the primary and secondary colors. YO, YG, RO, RV, BG, BV
