	A <i>common noun</i> names a general person, place or thing.	

examples: I went to the <u>city</u>.

The <u>man</u> was kind.

A **proper noun** names a specific person, place, or thing. Always capitalize the first letter of a proper noun.

examples: I went to San Francisco.

Mr. Brown was kind.

My new puppy, <u>Perro</u>, is playful.
