<u>POSTAL</u>	<p>VERB: SEND + POST PASSIVE</p> <p>The postman delivers the letters. The letters are delivered by the postman.</p> <p>CONSTRUCTION: SEND IS/AM + PAST PARTICIPLE</p> <p>They're interestedly into all the stamps. It's being introduced at the moment</p>
<u>POST</u>	<p>VERB: RECOVER + PAST PARTICIPLE</p> <p>They sent the package by train. The package was sent by train.</p> <p>CONSTRUCTION: RECOVER + PAST PARTICIPLE</p> <p>My watch was stolen by my mother. My suit was being stolen by my mother</p>
<u>POSTAL SERVICE</u>	<p>VERB: DELIVER IS/AM + PAST PARTICIPLE</p> <p>They have sent all the letters. All the letters have been sent.</p>
<u>POST OFFICE</u>	<p>VERB: RECEIVE + PAST PARTICIPLE</p> <p>They had received the papers. The papers had been received.</p>
<u>STATION</u>	<p>VERB: ARRIVE + PAST PARTICIPLE</p> <p>My brother will meet me at the station. I will be met at the station by my brother.</p> <p>CONSTRUCTION: ARRIVE IS/AM + PRESENT PARTICIPLE</p> <p>I'm going to work on it. I look to going to be written.</p>
<u>BOOKS, LIBRARY</u>	<p>VERB: CALL IS/AM RELATIVE CLAUSE IS/AM + PAST PARTICIPLE</p> <p>I interact with a book. I think must be written</p>
