### Handwriting Checklist

1. Does I understand question?
2. Does I have sufficient evidence to justify answer the question?
3. Did I have an introduction, development & conclusion (question to reader, 2-3 body paragraphs, conclusion) that relates to the question?
4. Does the body contain all parts of the question?
5. Does I have started each paragraph of the body so that it has a clear connection of evidence to develop stronger evidence and supportive paragraphs?
6. Does the conclusion provide closure to the topic and evidence makes full for the topic?
7. Does the length of the introduction, development paragraphs & conclusion?
8. Does the page is handwritten, and there is no handwriting error, illegible handwriting, or wrong number of pages.
9. Does I used passive for ideas and direct questions using the main idea/picture from teacher?
10. Does my writing satisfy the teacher's required standard?  
For example:
  - a. Writing on one side of the paper.
  - b. Legible handwriting.
11. Is my writing appropriate for the level standard?
  - a. Spelling
  - b. Grammar
  - c. Organization, including any diagram/outline
  - d. Is it regular to connect the words together clearly so that people can understand and differentiate between the writing words?
12. Is the evidence for understanding and justifying the teacher's requirement?
