

## FIFTH GRADE READING 6<sup>th</sup> SIX WEEKS

**Assessments:** Assess student reading level using the STAR Assessment. Use the Scott Foresman IRI if a student is one year or more below grade level on the STAR. Record scores on the K-12 Language Arts Record Card.

Students are working in the Scott Foresman 5<sup>th</sup> grade basal or other 5<sup>th</sup> grade student literature.

### **Reading/Literature (50%)**

#### **Literature Content**

Fiction (20%)

Nonfiction (20%) – Related to subject matter in core areas; includes documents and speeches important to American history to 1877

Poetry (10%)

The students will read silently and independently during SSR time 30 minutes a day. The students will read fluently in grade level material (120 words per minute).
