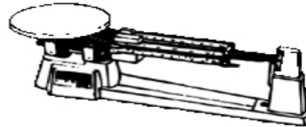


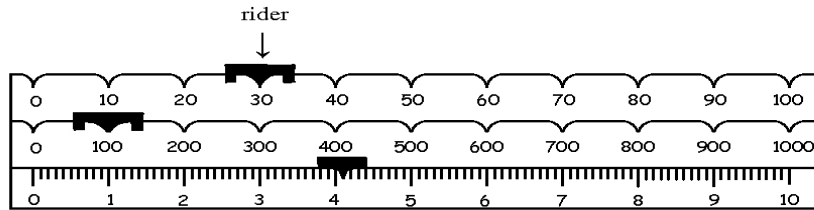


Measuring Mass

In the Metric System, mass is measured in grams (g) using a triple-beam balance. It is called a triple-beam because it has three beams that are used to determine the mass of an object.



On each beam, there is a rider which can be moved to different reading until the object is balanced.
