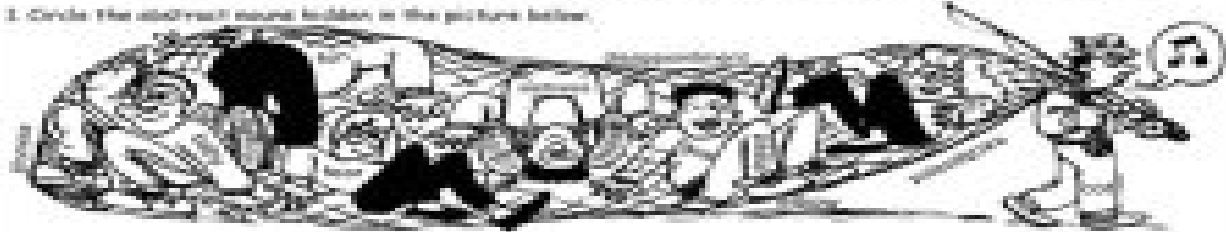


ABSTRACT NOUNS

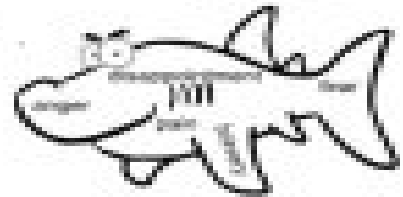
