Draw your baby's attention to the four babies on this page. Put your finger on one of the babies, touching and naming the nose, mouth, hair, chin, ear, eye, leg, arm, elbow, tummy, chest, head. Next, touch your baby's hand to the same parts of the babies' bodies. Continue the game by pointing to different parts of your child's body and naming them.



Give your baby several stickers and help him place them on different parts of your body (hand, elbow, nose, etc.). Repeat as many times as you wish. You could also call out a part of the body and see if your child can place the sticker correctly on his own body.
