### Cornell System of Note-taking

### 2-part system

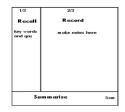
### System can be divided into two parts

- layout of notesprocessing of notes

## Paper type

### 1. Layout

- <u>vur</u> large paper (A4, legal...), so plenty of room loose leaf binder (re-arrange later & insert handouts)
- use only left-hand page



Layout

- 2. Making notes
   write legibly
   capture general ideas (purpose to understand lecture)
  - leave blank line between main points, indent sub-points
    use abbreviations

  - note sources at the time
  - notes needn't be neat, but must understand use pics, mindmaps etc.

### Recall

How to make notes?

Review - why? & how?

3. Recall column
Condense notes into single words/phrases/questions. Forces you to understand and helps prompt memory.

### 4. Other stages

- reciting can help you remember
- re-writing/summarising lecture useful but value???

- i. immediately after lecture recall stage ii. time each week for prev. material helps
- - macro understanding - memorisation
