



In this sentence, *where* is a relative adverb (*where* = in which). The clause it introduces is an adjective clause, not an adverb clause. It modifies the noun *housing*. *Housing* is an ordinary noun, not a gerund. *Moons* is an adverbial objective modifying the adverb *ago*. One can also construe *ago* as an adjective modifying *moons*.
